Have not heard from *Dances with Waves*, maybe they will check-in soon. Hope their travels have been good.

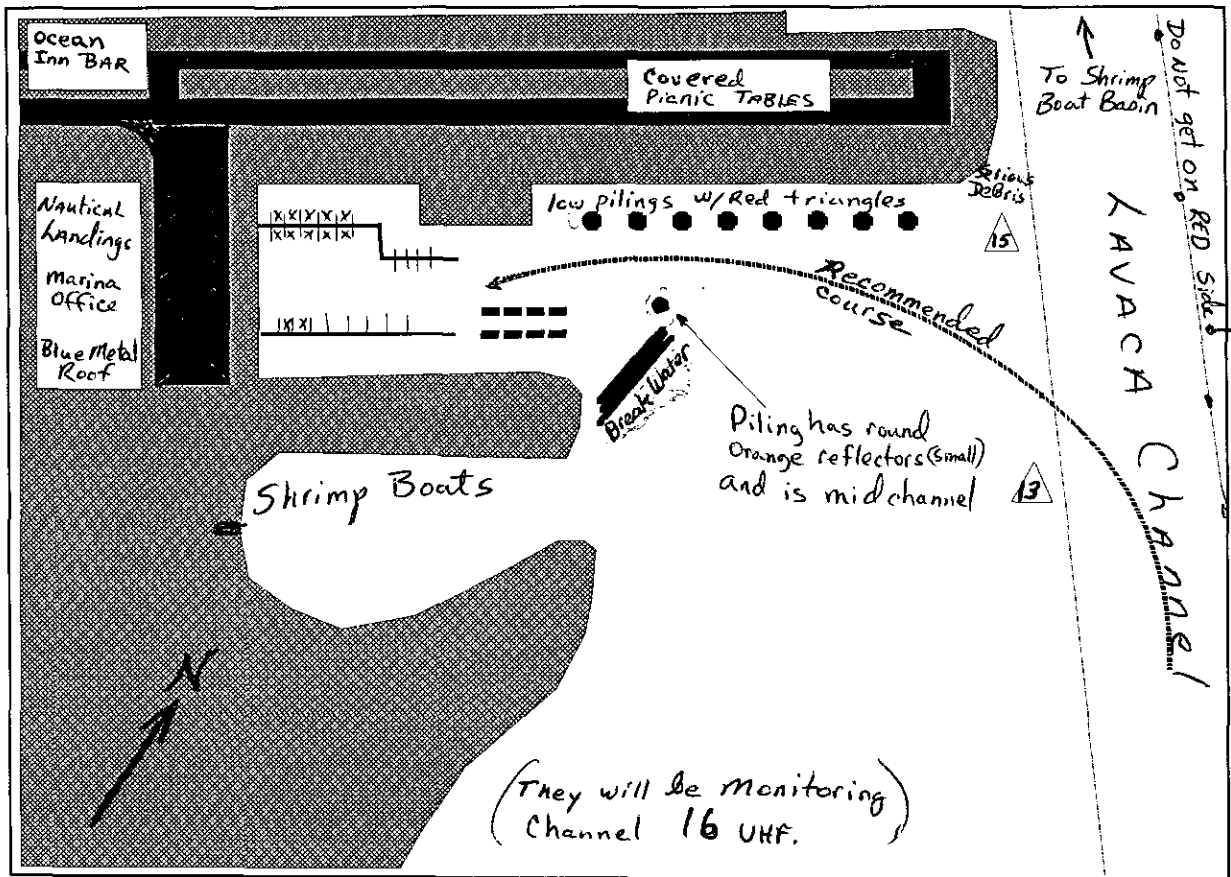
