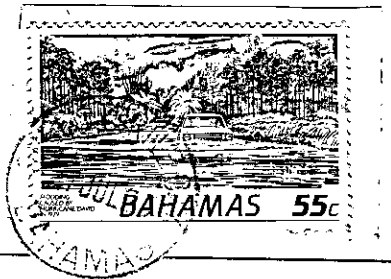
### ***REPORT CARD 1993***

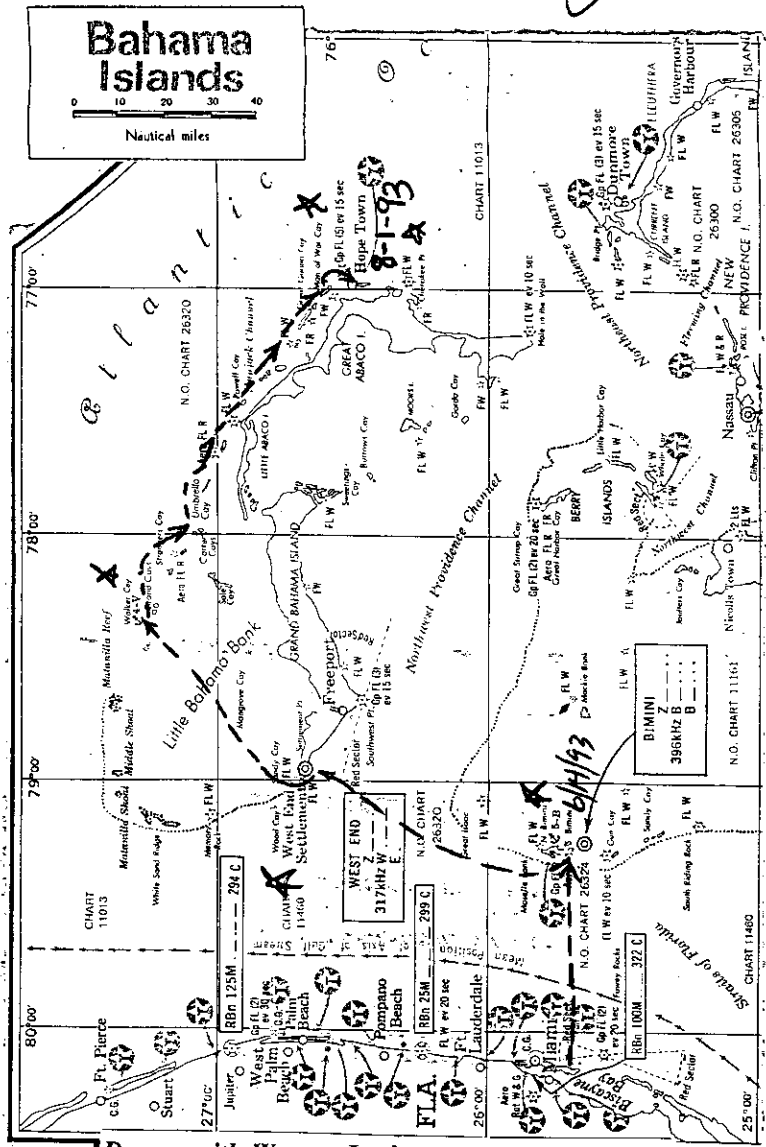

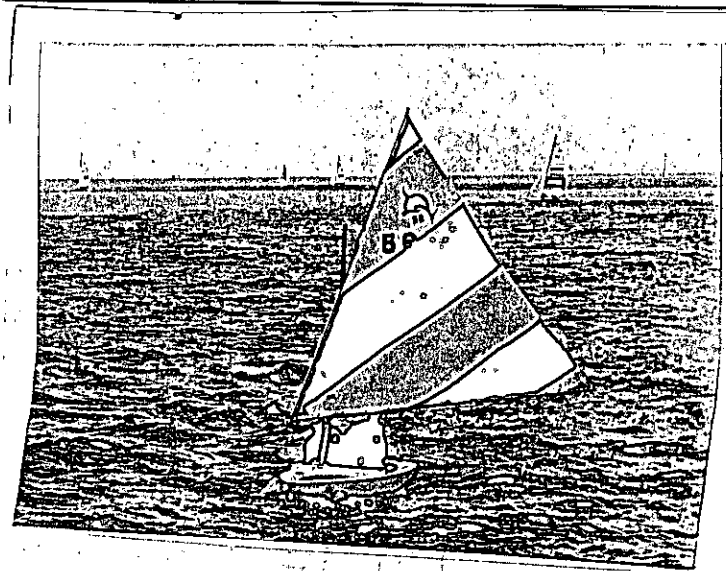
