1994 Over All - after 10 races:

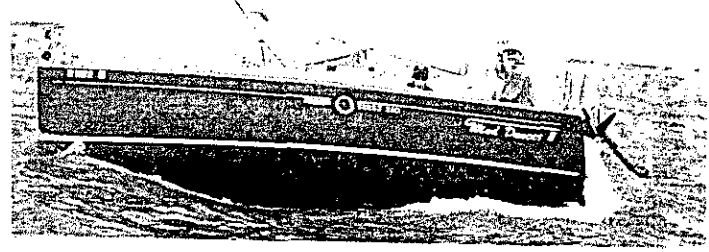

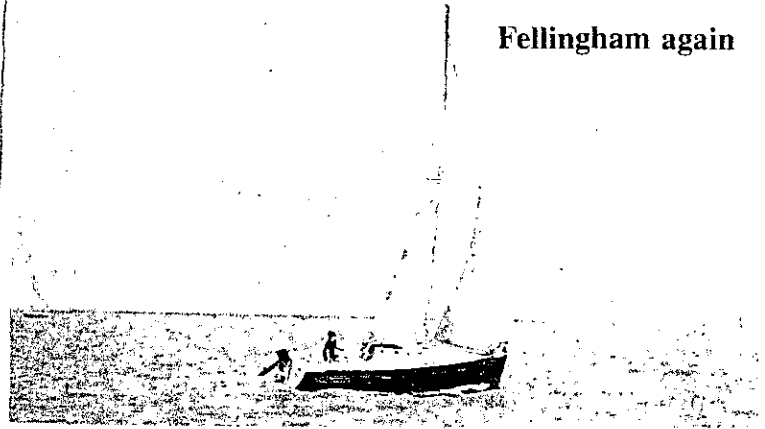

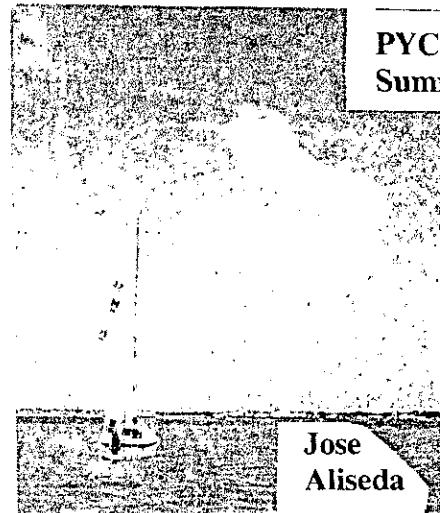

Fellingham again

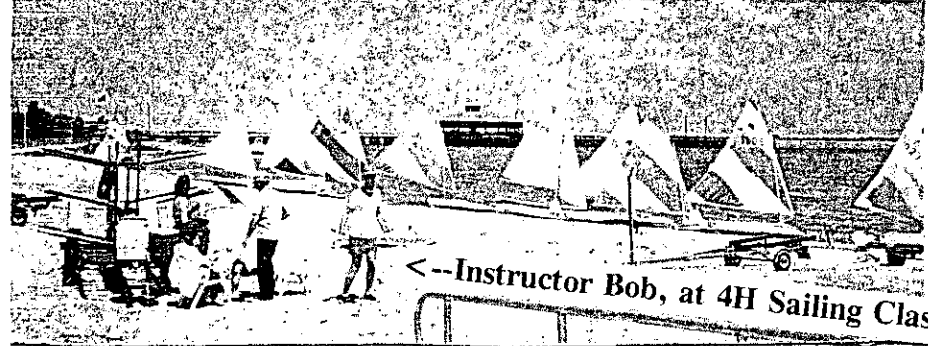


PYC 1994 Summer Race

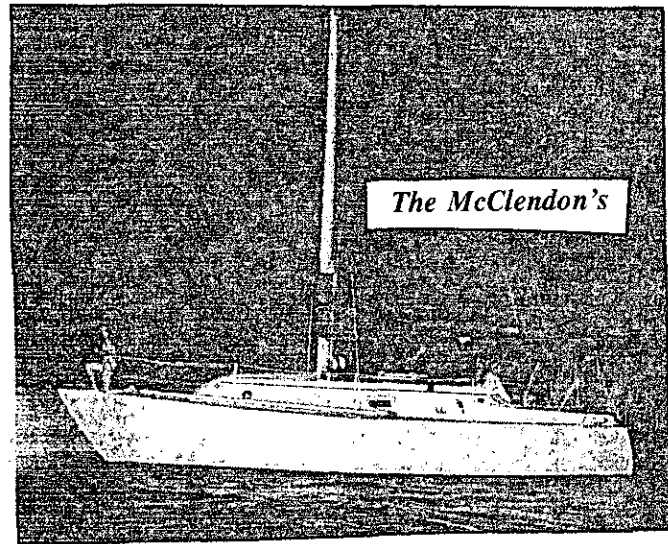
